I am requesting funding for the Washougal Wastewater Treatment Plant Anoxic Selector Project in fiscal year 2023. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Washougal located at 1701 C Street, Washougal WA 98671.

This effort will seek to support the installation of a new, required Anoxic Selector at the Washougal Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP). The project is the next component of a multi-phase expansion and upgrade process.
